Specifically, the **Radcliffe Line** revealed on this very day, in 1947. It birthed two nations and caused the death of a million people.

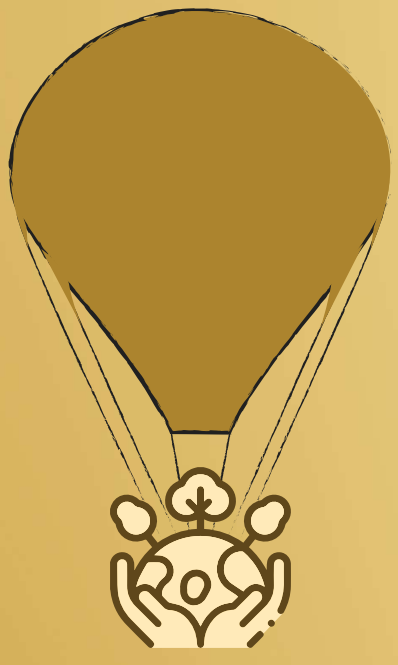

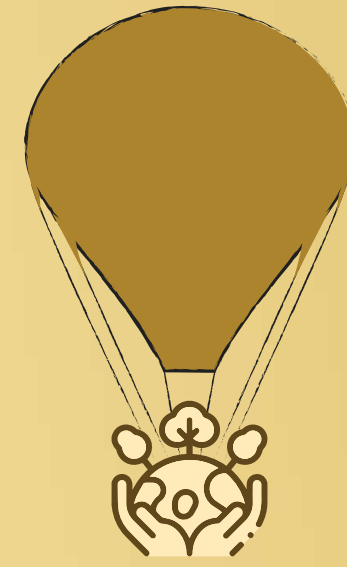

## PEOPLE FOR ANIMALS

Animals have been subjected to great cruelty, especially after the advent of colonialism in India. Whether it is wildlife, pet animals or farm (food) animals, the torture and horrors that most animals undergo is beyond explanation.

**Maneka Gandhi** has spent a major part of her life fighting for the cause of animals and has brought in several important legislations for animal welfare. She has been an activist, environmentalist and leader of animal rights.

She founded '**People for Animals**' (PFA) in 1992 and has set up 35 shelters across India. She is responsible for introducing in Parliament the Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules 2001 - which was first introduced by the Blue Cross of India in Chennai. She is also a writer and author of several books, including the Heads and Tails series and Animal Laws of India.

She will speak at IWA on her mission on animal welfare.

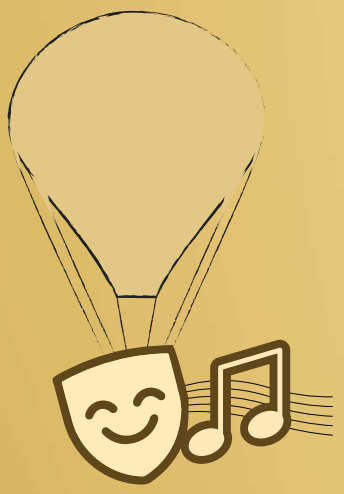
