



Vidhushi Shanti Rao of Bangalore, is a dedicated veena artist both at home and abroad as seen from the numerous eulogistic media reports. Her performances have been praised not only for pure classicism and virtuosity of play but also for aesthetic and captivating rendition of raga, kriti and swara.

Vidhushi Shanti Rao began her long and successful musical voyage at a tender age of twelve. In 1969, on moving to Bombay, she was captivated by the sounds of the veena being played by none other than veena legend Chitti Babu who was later to become her guru. "I had never heard the veena being played that way". That turned her from being a passive listener to an avid player. She began studying the veena under the tutelage of Chitti Babu.

Shanti Rao toured around the world winning the hearts of both Indians abroad and people unfamiliar with Indian classical music and/or the divine instrument. She has become a popular ambassador of her country, having performed at important functions and even having had the privilege of performing before Queen Elizabeth II.



Vinod Daniel will highlight what museums are and do, what is the future of museums, how do museums conserve their collections, how do museums stay relevant.




His published works include a novel, a play, translations of books and verse.



TURTLE TALK - A VOICE FOR THE VOICELESS


Our speaker Dr. Supraja Dharini has worked relentlessly to create awareness for the cause of protecting thousands of nesting turtles along east coast beaches and ensured the survival and safe release of almost two and a half million baby sea turtles or 'hatchlings' into the sea, by involving the local fishing communities along Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and southern Odisha coast. She is their spokesperson and will share snippets of the incredible work that her organisation, TREE Foundation, does for the conservation of sea turtles and protection of endangered marine life along our coast.

Supraja Dharini, inspired by Dr. Jane Goodall, founded the TREE Foundation in 2002, to conserve olive ridley sea turtles along the Indian east coast. Over the past 21 years, she has adopted a multi-disciplinary approach to this initiative by involving unemployed youth from fishing communities. Through the Sea Turtle Protection Force (STPF), she has protected thousands of nests, releasing over 36 million hatchlings. STPF members educate fishing communities on conservation, ghost net retrieval, and pollution reduction, reaching 200,000 community members. TREE Foundation has created awareness among 3,00,000 students and 4,000 officials. Supraja gained support for Turtle Excluder Devices from 2,000 trawl fishermen. She received the Explorers Club 50/50 membership award in 2020. She has presented at international conferences and published peer-reviewed papers on sea turtle conservation.
