



Her delve back into textiles happened in a depthful manner in the last ten years. Her creativity has been challenged each day in making varied pieces of textiles from bags, home goods and quilts. She utilizes different varied textile mediums to create her pieces. She has taught her art to many in the US and Singapore. She will be taking us through a journey of Kantha embroidery.

Kantha embroidery originated in India, but is best known from the area of Bengal and Bangladesh. The word Kantha means "patched cloth." It is rightly called a recycling art. As it was old dothis and sarees which were the original source of Kantha threads, the traditional colours were yellow, red, green, black and blue. Nowadays, chemical colours and variations can be found, which also creates beautiful pieces.







Our heartfelt gratitude to Lalitha Krishnan for hosting this meeting, and her daughter Gowri Tirumurti for opening her home to IWA.







Navratri is a nine day autumn festival revering the feminine divine. Although it is recognised across the length and breadth of India, the long standing tradition of Golu marks the celebrations here in the southern states.

At the age of 88, G.S. Kalpakkam still continues this rich tradition which was started by her mother-in-law Sundari ammal.

G.S.Kalpakkam conceptualises the unique displays of Gowri dolls that depict scenes rooted in folklore, history, or our holy scriptures. The ideas behind the annual spectacular arrangements are usually planted 3 months in advance after they are nurtured just to come to life for the nine nights and ten days of Navratri. The underlying theme is always the victory of good over evil, which is what Navratri always stands for.

This year she opens the doors of her home for us to discover what is her theme this year and what prompts her to embark upon this rather strenuous but blessed journey year after year.







Finding courage to pursue a full-time career in the art form upon encouragement from her guru, she is committed to building a holistic understanding of the arts. She was blessed with the opportunity to watch, learn, and assimilate through Abhinaya classes under Guru Smt. Kalanidhi Narayanan, and has also trained in nattuvangam, music and Tamil texts.

Shweta is the recipient of numerous awards, including the National Balashree from the President of India, the late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam in 2004. She is an ICCR empanelled artist and has represented the Subcontinent as the Indian delegate for the 2008 Commonwealth Day celebrations in Male, Maldives and the 2004 International Classical & Folk Music and Dance Festival in Kyrgyzstan.

In Chennai, Shweta is a regular performer as part of the Music and Dance season every year. With a deep commitment to continue exploring the versatility and sharing the joys of Bharata Natyam even in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic, Shweta has tenaciously engaged in several avenues to do so. Taking impetus from her initial collaboration with Carnatic musician Rithvik Raja at the Society Dharani in Kochi in 2017, the duo paired up once again to present two other editions of Samvaada, virtual conversations through dance and music, for the Colorado Fine Arts Association and Ananya Bangalore.

Outside of her ventures with Bharata Natyam, Shweta was part of the first ever Indian Women's Rugby team to have represented the country in Thailand for the Asian Seven's in 2009. She also holds a Master's in commerce from Pune University.
