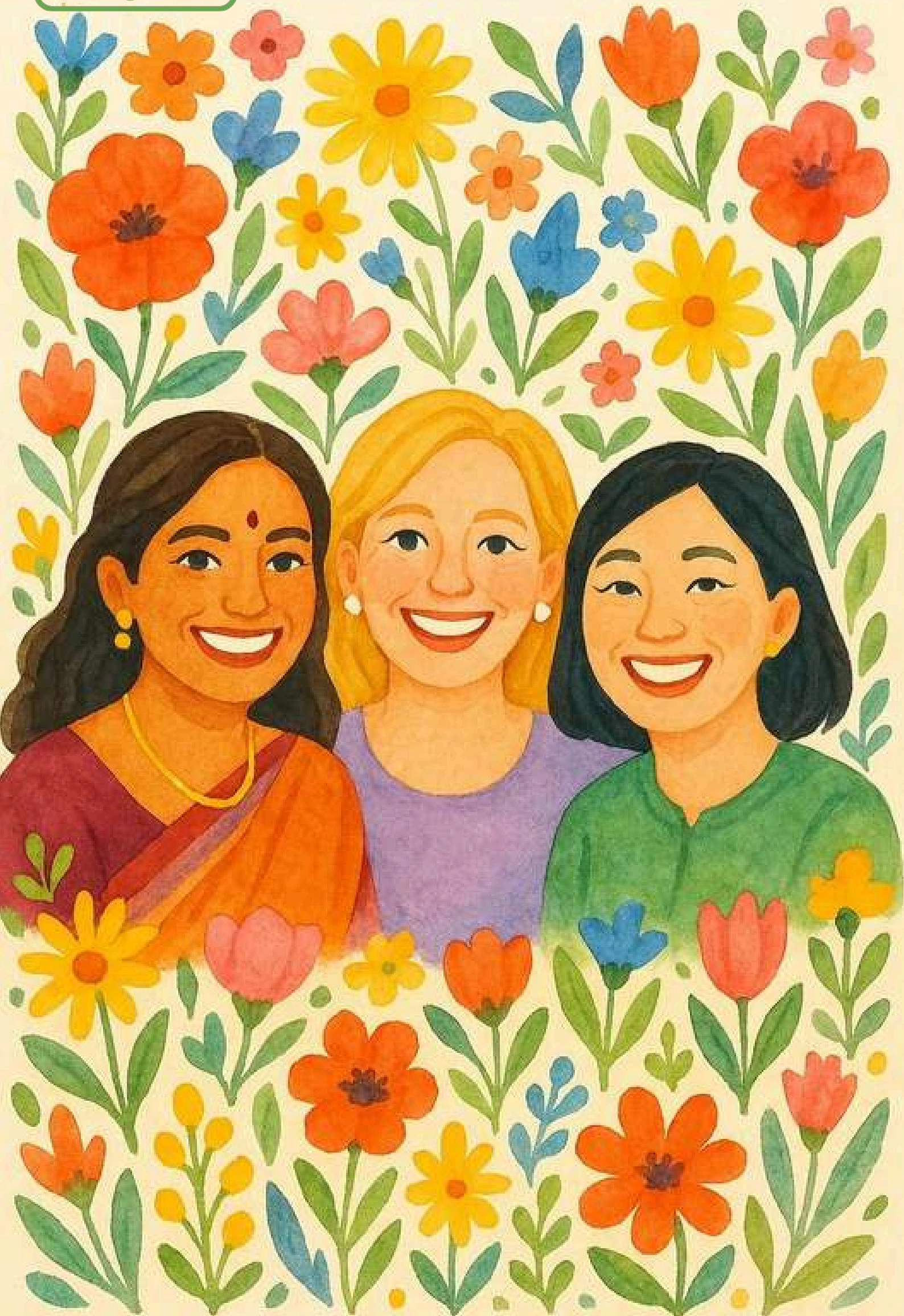

## THREADS THAT TRAVELLED A THOUSAND YEARS: The Story of the Saurashtras

This month's book discussion has a special connection to our own community — the story being explored is also the story of our own IWA member **Shalini Biswajit**, her family and her heritage.

**Biswajit Balasubramanian** is a **Chennai-based** cartoonist, sculptor and visual artist celebrated for blending humour with sharp social insight. He began his cartooning career with *Madras Musings*, where his pocket cartoons quickly developed a devoted readership and were later compiled into the book *Chennai Latte – A Madras Brew*. Along with his wife **Shalini**, he co-founded **Chennai's** respected **Forum Art Gallery**. A recipient of the **Special Jury Award** at the **Maya Kamath Memorial Awards**, his creative work spans illustration, branding and exhibitions.

**Anitha Rajarajan**, a graduate of **Stella Maris College**, is a writer, heritage enthusiast and community leader whose work celebrates culture, memory and storytelling. Founder of **Soroptimist International Madurai**, she has been internationally recognised for her work empowering women and girls and was honoured among 100 Distinguished Soroptimists worldwide during the organisation's centenary. Through curated culinary experiences, documentary films and writing, she brings the traditions of the **Sourashtra** community vividly to life.

Our host Vidya will moderate the meeting, and along with the authors, will take us on a fascinating journey across nearly a thousand years, tracing how the **Sourashtrians** travelled from the **Saurashtra** region of **Gujarat** across **India** before eventually settling in **Madurai**. Through stories, illustrations and personal insights, they will explore the community's unique language, traditions, cuisine and their celebrated weaving heritage, especially the exquisite **Sungudi** textiles. More than a history lesson, this is a story about resilience, identity and the art of adapting while staying rooted.

Come discover a remarkable journey across time — one that begins centuries ago and leads right to someone within our own IWA family.

## SUNFLOWERS IN THE CHENNAI SUN: A City in Bloom

Our member **Shefalii Dadabhoy** is the founder of the ***Chennai Sunflower City*** initiative — a citizen-led movement that encourages individuals to actively participate in greening the city by planting sunflowers in their homes, schools, and public spaces.

With over a decade of experience in the corporate sector, **Shefalii** later chose to pursue her creative passions, establishing ventures in photography, baking, and curated food experiences. Throughout her journey, her work has consistently reflected a deep appreciation for beauty, community, and the natural world.

The idea for ***Chennai Sunflower City*** was born from a simple moment in her own garden, when she realised the uplifting impact sunflowers can have on a space. What began as a small effort—sharing seeds and growing instructions with friends—quickly grew into a larger city-wide movement. Today, citizens, schools, organisations, and the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) are participating in planting sunflowers across balconies, terraces, gardens, and public areas throughout Chennai.

At its core, the initiative aims to reconnect people with nature while encouraging small, collective actions that can transform the character of a city. Through this movement, Shefalii hopes to inspire citizens to take ownership of their environment and help place Chennai on the global map as one of the world's most beautiful and ecologically conscious cities.

What do a scarf, a mirror, and a stone have to do with travel? Find out as award-winning journalist Vasanthi Hariprakash takes us on a refreshingly personal journey—one that's part memoir, part map for the bold and the hesitant alike.

From navigating the outer world to exploring the inner one, this session is about travelling light, staying curious, and moving forward with courage—wherever you are in life.

**Vasanthi Hariprakash** is an award-winning journalist, multilingual speaker, and media entrepreneur whose storytelling has captivated audiences across India. Nominated by Narayana Murthy to represent India at the Salzburg Global Leadership Forum, she has been described by philanthropist Rohini Nilekani as “a force of nature.”

She is the Founder & CEO of Pickle Jar Media, which creates podcasts, curates events, and trains founders and women leaders in communication and media readiness. With over two decades in journalism and broadcasting, she has worked across leading newsrooms, including NDTV 24x7, The New Indian Express, All India Radio Akashvani, and Radio City 91.1 FM.

A two-time TEDx speaker, she has delivered keynote talks at IIT Madras, BITS Pilani, and Manipal University, drawing from reporting journeys across India to explore themes such as the future of work, the India beyond mainstream headlines, and the power of voice and leadership.

Her work has earned several honours, including the Laadli Award for Gender Sensitivity in Journalism (2020, 2023), the Bangalore Press Club Journalist of the Year Award (2022), the PRCI Dazzling Daughter Award (2014), and India's English RJ of the Year at the Radio Excellence Awards (2007).

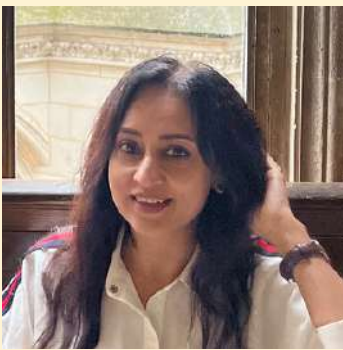
