## SssssScaling Up to New Heights ZAI WHITAKER'S CROCODILE TALES

Zai is managing trustee of the Madras Crocodile Bank, which she started in 1976 along with her then husband Rom Whitaker. Apart from her interest in wildlife and its conservation, she is an author with 22 published books, most of them for children including Cobra in my Kitchen, Andamans Boy, & Kali & The Rat Snake to name a few.


Her other interest is education. She taught at **Kodai International School** for 18 years and was principal of two schools, **Outreach** in **Bangalore** and **Abacus Montessori** in **Chennai**.

In her session, Zai will speak about her book Scaling Up - about some of her adventures with Rom in the field after she moved to Chennai in 1974. This includes her meeting with the Adivasi snake catchers the Irular, who caught and sold millions of snakes to the snake skin industry before it was banned. Her work with Rom included developing the Snake Park, Crocodile Bank and other projects. She will speak about the Crocodile Bank today and plans for its further development. Zai will also talk about how the Scaling-Up project began, and take us through a few pages from it.

In this **Members Speak** series, we spotlight three women who don't just talk about wellbeing and sustainability — they live it. Their journeys span classrooms, counselling rooms, city balconies, and farmland, reminding us that health is emotional, environmental, and deeply personal.

#### Usha Krishnamurthy — A Life Spent Showing Up for Others

Usha's story reads like a map of service: a young accounting teacher in Uttar Pradesh, a scribe, a guide for students with learning challenges, and now, as a counsellor. She'll talk about the life-lessons stitched into these experiences over 35 years — and share a few tools that can steady us when everything feels too much.

#### Priya Gopalen — Where Kids, Cities, and Plants Meet

The belief that even a cramped city balcony can hold a little magic turned into *The Magic Bean*, where Priya teaches people — especially children — to grow their own food in the spaces they already have. She'll take us into the world of microgreens: tiny, flavourful, power-packed greens with a surprising amount of wellness.

#### Suguna Anumolu — Farming With Heart, Not Just Technique

At her 60-acre regenerative farm, *Anmol Harvest*, Suguna works with nature rather than against it. What she has built is more than a farm; it's a living example of how biodiversity, patience, and intuition can heal both land and people. She'll talk about her journey and the power of regenerative farming that restores both land and community.


